



Clubhouse Covid-19 Guidance UPDATE March 2022

Following the most recent government announcements we are now following Covid Guidance summarised as follows:

The government has removed the remaining domestic restrictions in England. There are still steps you can take to reduce the risk of catching and spreading COVID-19:

- Get vaccinated
- Let fresh air in if meeting indoors, or meet outside
- Consider wearing a face covering in crowded, enclosed spaces
- Get tested if you have COVID-19 symptoms, and stay at home if positive

It is clear for most the pandemic has not gone away. Despite the vaccinations for many there are still risks. Consequently, we should all continue to act in the best interests of our members, employees and visitors. Whatever we think as individuals, respecting others is a key value of our club.

We have put systems in place to safeguard our members, employees and visitors. We have installed multiple hand sanitising stations and introduced a cleaning schedule which involves disinfecting 'high traffic areas' throughout the day.

Our team members will be taking regular Lateral Flow Tests, particularly before larger gatherings. We encourage all our members to do likewise.

Members, employees and visitors must comply with Government Safety Guidelines.

If you have, or are experiencing symptoms of Covid-19, please do not come to the Club. Call to advise us so we can notify others you may have been in contact with.

Please Continue to:

- Wash your hands regularly for 20 seconds with warm soapy water
- Use the 4 sanitiser stations we have provided for you
- Order food and drink at the bar, pay with club card, CC or DC, no cash
- Take a terrace or bar seat for table service
- Presentations & functions will proceed, note comments on crowded spaces.

Council feel it appropriate to continue to exercise caution at this stage to protect members, employees and visitors as much as is feasible. We will review our operations in line with further Government updates.
